COPA COVID-19 Testing Changes

This week ConocoPhillips Alaska will be making several important changes to COVID-19 testing requirements. Please review this information for your specific situation. Thank you for your ongoing diligence limiting the impact of COVID-19 to our people and business through your prevention practices.

Travel Testing Suspended:

After the final flight on **1/28/22**, COPA will be suspending the requirement for unvaccinated or unattested travelers to obtain a negative COVID-19 test prior to travel to the North Slope.

Post Travel Testing for Wells and Capital Projects Suspended:

After **1/28/22**, COPA will no longer be conducting routine post-travel testing for personnel in the Wells or Capital Projects organizations.

Testing for Individuals with Approved Accommodations:

Capstone Clinics will remain on site at each location through 1/30/22 to support this testing.

Starting 1/31/22, company and contractor employees in mandated groups who have approved religious or medical accommodations requiring weekly testing will be able to complete testing with the Alpine or Kuparuk medical clinics by making an appointment.

Weekly Testing Plans Under OSHA ETS Suspended:

COPA is suspending plans for weekly testing of unvaccinated or unattested individuals at this time, pending final resolution of the OSHA Emergency Temporary Standard (ETS).

All personnel are reminded that they should continue to self-screen for symptoms and seek a test and or medical care if they have any symptoms or are a close contact.
